Friday, May 9, 2014, at 13,00 was the deadline for submission to the Ministry of Economy of proposals relating to the Programme "Energy Efficiency" in the industry for SMEs (RO 05), funded by the European Economic Area Financial Mechanism.

Five projects were submitted from five companies (SMEs). The total value of projects is 23,238,782 Lei, and the amount of requested grant is 10,643,617 Lei. These figures do not cover the amount of the grant for this program.

The Ministry of Economy as the Programme Operator for externally funded programme "RO 05 Energy Efficiency" will start to evaluating these projects according to the criteria set out in Guidelines for Applicants and in the provisions of Application Regulations.

After the evaluation session, the Ministry of Economy and the Ministry of European Funds will determine the conditions for launching a new call for submission of new projects for energy efficiency in industry.

In this regard, we invite eligible companies, Small and Medium Enterprises, to follow the site www.minind.ro, in Section EEA Grants, the evolution of programme development and continue to pay attention to energy efficiency - implementation of new, efficient technologies, modern installations and equipment that contribute to energy savings and increased competitiveness.

We recall that:

- The specific objective of this program is to reduce the CO₂ footprint through energy savings in industry and the reduction of GHG emissions. Priority will be given to those projects that provide the greatest reduction in CO₂ emissions relative to resources allocated within grant programme (target: tCO₂/1000 Euro).
- The grant amount is EUR 8,000,000 (EEA funds) and 1,411,765 financing (Ministry of Economy), in total 9,411,765 Euro.
